

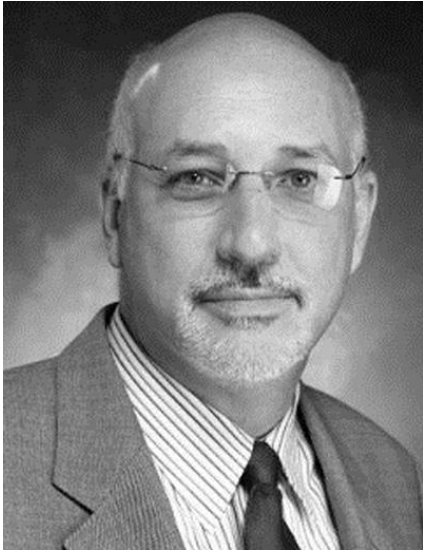

- Communication
- Flexibility
- Monitoring processes and protocols
- Reversal plan

## 4. Coordination With Landlord/Building/Property Management

- Is the building ready?
  - Climate control
  - Lobby reception
  - Security
  - Maintenance
  - Housekeeping/janitorial
  - Access control/health screening/PPE requirements
  - Visitors
  - Access control deliveries and pick-ups

# 5. Testing/Health Screening & Access Control

- Health screening management and staffing
- PPE for health screeners
- Documenting health screening and confidentiality
- Screening methods (thermal imaging/non-contact thermometers)
- Barriers & PPE for screeners
- Secondary screening
- Screening location/logistics

## 6. Social Distancing & PPE

- Must be operationally practical
- Physical separation of work spaces
- Staggered work shifts
- Common areas
  - Conference rooms
  - Lunch/break rooms
  - Printing/copy areas
- Personal Protective Equipment (supplies, signage, training)
